## B. Committee Reports

### a. **Athletics Report** – Rod Wiebers, Activities Director

#### i. Fall Sports Recap:

- Cheerleading finished their competition season with a 3rd place finish at the Iowa Cheer Finals.
- Volleyball finished 2nd in the conference. They were defeated in the regional semi-final.
- Cross Country Boys and Girls had very successful seasons, both qualified for state. The Girls finished 5th and Boys 12th.
- Football made it to the UNI Dome, finishing in the top four in the state for 3A.
- Dance has their State competition on Friday, Dec 2nd.

#### ii. Winter Sports have been practicing and will begin competition soon. The first Mega-Night for Girls and Boys basketball is Tuesday, Nov 29.

#### iii. Coaching positions:

#### iv. State Trophies are going to do something new and travel to each of the elementary schools for a week to be showcased. Reps look for an email from Ryan on finalizing the names on the trophies.

### b. **Financial** - Carl Duffy

Carl reported on the status of overall cash in accounts. Recent activity includes money spent for Cheer and Football state meals and shirts.

### c. **Apparel** - Gretchen Rickert

- Holiday online order closed Sunday night. This order had a very short turn-around, and we still ended with 83 orders.
- Pop-Up sale held at Basketball's Meet the Team night resulted in about \$2000 in sales.
- Considering doing one more Pop-Up sale before Christmas.

### d. **Business Membership** - Ryan Case

## C. New Items / Open Discussion

### a. **Basketball Tournament**

Save the dates of Jan 21/22 (girls) and Jan 28/29 (boys) to assist with gym marshall duties. Ryan Smith (previous girls basketball rep) has agreed to continue to run the tournament after Ryan Case retires. Sign-ups doing very good for boys, only 3 open spots remain. Girls still have 21 open spots.

### b. **ESports:** Chris Hatchitt contacted Ryan about the potential of including ESports with Booster Club. This is on hold for now.

### c. **State Swimming:** Ryan shared how Freshman Hayden Bailey participated in the State Championship swim meet with the Waukee swim team. The Booster Club showed their support of Hayden by offering funds for a shirt and meal, the same as we do for all other state qualifying teams from ADM. Work is being done to get her picture and a plaque displayed at ADM in recognition.

### d. **Coaches Requests Budgeting**

- i. Ryan shared how this year we received a record number of requests from coaches, but also how we have a record amount of funds. Looking back our budget has more than doubled what it was five years ago.
- ii. Next Rod explained how he categorized the coaches requests including how some things requested can be paid for by the school.
- iii. After discussion on how the budget and recommendations were determined there were no additional questions or concerns from reps.
- iv. Ryan Case made a motion to approve everything on the Totals spreadsheet. Eric Hietz seconded the motion. All reps supported it and the motion passed.
- v. Reps should inform their coaches which requests were approved and which requests were noted as things the school will pay for. Coaches can proceed with purchasing items on the totals spreadsheet and submit expenses to the school for the Booster Club to reimburse.
- vi. Huge thanks to everyone, especially Rod, for making this process so efficient and all the reps help raising funds so we have the budget to fulfill so many requests!
