## B. Committee Reports

a. Athletics Report - Rod Wiebers, Activities Director
i. Fall sports kicking off this week with volleyball, football and boys XC, girls will have XC next weekend in Pella to start season. All fall teams are starting off ranked in the top 10. So good start to the season for the Tigers. Cheer has started and will be holding a youth clinic in September; Dance team will be performing at some of the football games during halftime.
ii. There has been a lot of growth overall of the fall sports teams, along with cheer and dance, which supports the school goals of wanting all of the kids in the hallways to be active, involved and part of the school.
iii. There are a few assistant coaching positions open for girls MS and boys HS basketball teams.

## b. Financial - Carl Duffy

i. Business memberships have started to come in with the start of the new school year.
ii. We are sitting really well financially and expect to have a great response to the membership drive next weekend.

## c. Apparel - Gretchen Rickert

d. Business Updates - Kelly Shull

ii. Rod has taken over the ad sales and we have a new 95 " screen in the gym due to a new contract.

## C. New Items / Open Discussion

a. Introduction of Chris Hatchitt - eSports Coach
i. Coach Hatchitt shared all of the details around the two leagues currently available to the ADM ESports team. The number of students who have been involved has grown each season; there are 3 seasons for the sport (fall/winter/spring) and the City of Adel is discussing a potential summer season with Chris that they support. The practices are run like any of the sport teams, with varsity practice and open play throughout the week, where they review team replays, discuss strategies for the games, etc. and the practices are very structured and organized. There has been a huge improvement in the soft skills with the students involved and a lot of excitement from them and all those involved. They have raised funds through the support of various Adel groups like the Lions and the Legion, as well as through individual donors and Chris's employer. The team is also participating in community service activities - did after prom, flags with the Lions, concessions at wrestling tourney.
ii. Coach Hatchitt has a lot of plans for continued growth with the team and the students and his passion and excitement were evident throughout his presentation.
